As the number of positive COVID-19 cases continue to rise, vaccines remain the single most effective weapon against the virus.

To make getting your COVID-19 vaccine more convenient, the Florida Department of Health in Pinellas County (DOH-Pinellas) sends its outreach team to community locations several times a week.

Outreach events this week are at large and small employers offering their staff the convenience of a COVID-19 vaccine at the workplace.

If your business would like DOH-Pinellas to set up a COVID-19 vaccine clinic at your location, complete the Survey Monkey request at <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/PinellasVaccineEvent> and our staff will contact you.

The Pfizer vaccine has received full approval from the Food & Drug Administration for those ages 16 and older; it is under emergency authorization for those ages 12 to 15 years of age. Outreach events are open to the public without an appointment. As always, vaccines are provided at no cost.

- **Wednesday, Sept. 1:** Outdoor vaccines at 200 Central Ave., St. Petersburg, 11 a.m. to 2 p.m.
