Requirements for School Attendance 2016-2017

A school physical, signed or stamped by a licensed examiner and dated within one year prior to registration, is required for each student initially entering a Florida school.

² The State of Florida requires students entering 7th grade to have received a Tdap (tetanus- diphtheria- pertussis) **prior to attending class**. A Tdap should be administered regardless of the interval since the last tetanus- or diphtheria-toxoid containing vaccine.

 $^{^{3}}$ Students are required to have three Hep B immunizations if the series was started at birth. A two-dose series is available for adolescents 11 - 15 years of age if needed.

⁴ **For incoming KG only:** A fifth dose of poliovirus is required if the fourth dose was administered prior to the 4th birthday. If the third dose was administered on or after the 4th birthday, a fourth dose is not required.

⁵ Pre-K students are required to have Hib immunization. Numbers of doses depend on type of vaccine and student's age.
