Other Options:

Breast Pumps from Insurance- Medicaid and Private Companies:

- Check with your insurance provider about obtaining a breast pump
- Some insurance companies may require a prescription from your doctor.
 Prescriptions would need to include that you need a double electric breast pump and the reason that you need it. Examples of reasons may include: return to work, infant in NICU, medically needy infant, poor latch, mom has inverted/flat nipples, baby is tongue tied, etc., (this is not a complete list of reasons, call your insurance company for more information)
