Dear Providers:

We hope that this letter finds you and the families that are part of your Family Child Care Home program safe and well.

Due to the Executive Order signed by Governor DeSantis on May 3, 2021, The Pinellas Board of County Commissioners has withdrawn their emergency order and mask ordinance.

Since there is no longer a local state of emergency, the Pinellas County Emergency Regulations that have been in effect since March of 2020, will cease at the close of business on Friday, May 7, 2021. They must be rescinded within 72 hours following the conclusion of the state of emergency.

This means that the Pinellas County Family Child Care Home capacity that is printed on your license is back in effect with no exceptions, and all other requirements that have been waived during the state of emergency will be back in place. Our Licensing Specialists will once again cite violations in these areas beginning Monday, May 10, 2021.

As for the mask ordinance, that was never a Pinellas County Licensing Regulation and no one received a violation for not wearing a mask from our organization. As a private entity, you can choose to continue to require masks or not. That is your business decision.

We encourage you to follow the CDC recommendations for childcare entities. However, you are **required** to continue reporting any communicable diseases (including COVID) to our Epidemiology Department and follow their recommendations to mitigate the spread of the virus.

On behalf of all of us at the Child Care Licensing Program, we wish you continued success in providing quality childcare for the children of Pinellas County.
