The Pinellas County License Board met on September 22, 2021 and approved the following increases to standards for Pinellas County.

X. Application, Fee, License

B. Fees

3. In addition to the application fee, each family child care home will be charged a license fee of <u>\$75.00.</u>

Implementation Date: November 1, 2021

How to maintain compliance: New and renewal applications received after November 1, 2021 will include a license fee of \$75.00.

3. In addition to the application fee, each large family child care home will be charged a license fee of \$100.00.

Implementation Date: November 1, 2021

How to maintain compliance: New and renewal applications received after November 1, 2021 will include a license fee of \$100.00.

X. Application, Fees, License

5. The cost for filing each petition for a waiver is \$100.00.

Implementation Date: November 1, 2021

How to maintain compliance: Any petitions for waiver will have to be accompanied by a payment of \$100.00.

B. Training Requirements

10. <u>Prior to becoming a licensed Family Child Care Home Operator, the applicant must attend the License Board's Prospective Home Provider Training if the applicant has not been a licensed family child care home Operator within the past two years in Pinellas County.</u>

Implementation Date: November 1, 2021

How to maintain compliance: When a prospective provider is interested in opening a licensed family child care home and has not been licensed in Pinellas County within the past two years, they must register for the class by contacting our office at (727) 507-4857.

IX. Application, Fees, License

B. Fees

4. Each family child care home will charged \$25.00 to add overnight care to the license at any time other than at issuance of an initial license or at the time of renewal.

How to maintain compliance: Any requests for overnight care to be added to license will have to be accompanied by a payment of \$25.00 and a request for change application. Once submitted an inspection will be conducted to allow for this change.
